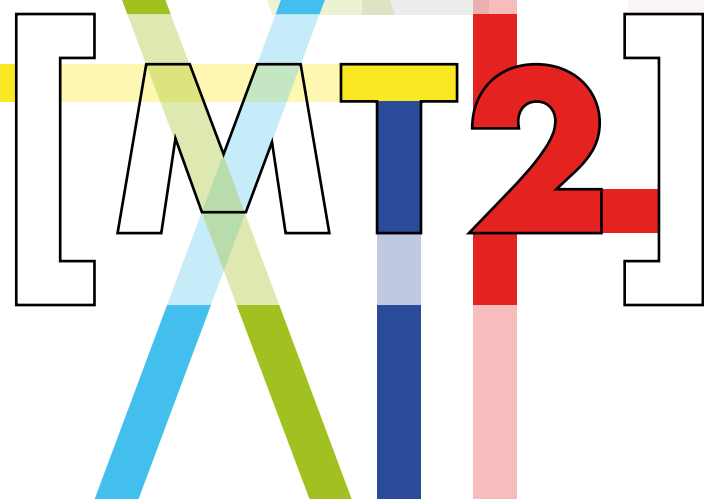

In the next years, the case of Metro Torino line 2 project could be an important stress-test for debate on contemporary Turinese urban design approaches.
