

## Entangled memory practices of sites of political violence

Welcome: Richard Lee Peragine Politecnico di Torino

Speakers: Gruia Bădescu University of Konstanz

In what ways do spatial practices of memorialisation become transnational? This talk will discuss how memorialisation practices of sites of political violence in different post-war and post-authoritarian geographical settings have circulated on a transnational level through connected processes and actors. It will engage with memory space-making and place-making in the Balkans and Latin America framed through a global perspective.

Gruia Badescu (PhD, Centre for Urban Conflicts Research, UK) is Alexander von Humboldt Postdoctoral Fellow at the Center for Cultural Inquiry Research, University of Konstanz (DE). His research interests lie at the intersection between architecture, memory practices and philosophy, which he has developed by focusing especially on post-conflict and post-dictatorship societies in South-Eastern Europe and the Latin American Southern Cone.
