Lone Søderkvist Kristensen (University of Copenhagen, Dept. of Geoscience and Natural Resource Management, Section Landscape Architecture and Planning) has more than 20 years of research and teaching experiences in Countryside Planning and Management. Her research topics include landscape changes in agricultural landscapes, farmers' landscape behavior, agricultural policy, policy integration, agri-environmental policies, spatial planning, and participation and collaborative planning. During the last 10 years, her research has focused on the practice of collaborative and strategic planning targeted rural landscapes. She has co-authored two books on the topic of the collaborative and strategic planning (in Danish) and several articles in international journals.
