Thomas Maloutas is Emeritus Professor at the Department of Geography, Harokopio University. Former Director of the Institute of Urban and Rural Sociology of the National Centre for Social Research (EKKE) (2001-2012), Professor at the Department of Planning, University of Thessaly (1991-2009) and General Secretary for Research & Technology (2015-2016). His research and published work is focused on segregation and gentrification processes, the stratification in metropolitan areas, and the restructuring of housing systems and welfare regimes in the era of capitalist globalisation.

SHORT TERM CITY Digital platform and spatial justice is a Research Project of National Relevance funded by the Italian Ministry of Education, University and Research dealing with how digital platforms are changing cities. The project's goal is to offer an empirically-situated understanding of the logics and (bio-) politics of platform capitalism and how to deal with it, with a particular focus on Italian cities and on the effects of the Covid-19 pandemic.
