The seminar will combine theoretical and practical perspectives on railway policy and regulation:

1. Analysis of regulatory structures,
2. Track Access Charges: Principles of cost allocation, market segmentation and mark-ups.
3. Discussion of political developments, including the role of EC working groups (e.g., SERAC, PRIME/ENIM), sustainability goals, and regulatory challenges in the railway and road transport sectors, with a special focus on Capacity regulation proposal and harmonisation of a traffic timetable.
