The Management Plan of the Ivrea Industrial City of the World Heritage represents a 20th Century Site comprehensive framework for safeguarding, understanding, and enhancing the outstanding universal value of a unique urban and architectural ensemble shaped by Olivetti's industrial and social vision.

Building on the principles of integrated conservation and participatory governance, the Plan combines protection and planning tools with strategies for knowledge dissemination, community engagement, and sustainable local development.

This presentation will outline the methodological approach adopted for the 2025-2030 update of the Management Plan, illustrating how the dialogue between heritage conservation, contemporary urban dynamics, innovation processes informs the site's long-term vision.
