This international workshop explores Regional Design as a strategic and visual tool to imagine new forms of urban nature, focusing on the Dora River in Turin and a possible future River Agreement.

Moving beyond technical approaches to river management, rivers are framed as socio-ecological systems shaped by politics, culture, and design. The workshop aims to produce transcalar proposals linking climate adaptation, biodiversity, social inclusion, and urban life, strengthening river agreements as participatory planning instruments.

Combining local institutional perspectives with international experiences from Europe and Latin America, lectures, site visits, mapping, and experimentation will support the development of regenerative and nature-based spatial visions.
