



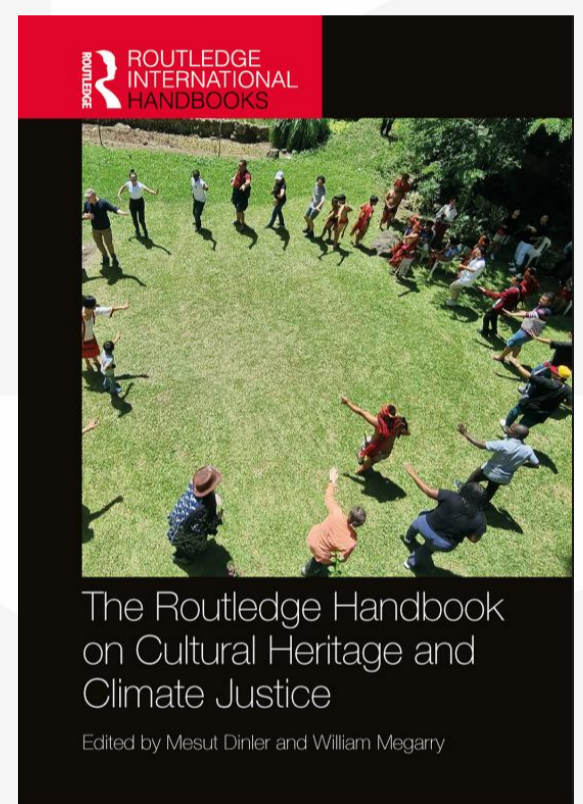
CULTURAL HERITAGE AND CLIMATE JUSTICE
